NOTE VERBALE DATED 25 JUNE 1996 FROM THE PERMANENT
MISSION OF GREECE TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Greece to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to his note dated 15 May 1996, in which a response regarding implementation of provisions of Security Council resolution 1054 (1996) of 26 April 1996 was requested, has the honour to report the following:

- The Sudan has no diplomatic or consular representation in Greece. Consequently, there was no need for any action to be taken by the Greek Government for the implementation of paragraph 3 (a) of the resolution.
- As regards paragraph 3 (b) of the resolution, no request has been submitted as of today according to its relevant provisions for granting permission to Sudanese officials to enter Greece.
