## NOTE VERBALE DATED 24 JUNE 1996 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF SLOVENIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Slovenia to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, pursuant to his note dated 15 May 1996, has the honour to inform him of the following measures taken by Slovenia in accordance with Security Council resolution 1054 (1996) of 26 April 1996.

On 29 April 1996, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Slovenia instructed all diplomatic missions and consulates of Slovenia to restrict, until further notice, the granting of visas for entry into or transit through its territory to persons referred to in subparagraph 3 (b) of resolution 1054 (1996). Simultaneously, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs informed the relevant border control bodies of these restrictions.

The Sudan has no diplomatic mission or consular post in Slovenia, therefore subparagraph 3 (a) of resolution 1054 (1996) does not apply.
