NOTE VERBALE DATED 21 JUNE 1996 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF GERMANY TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Germany to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General and, with reference to his note dated 15 May 1996, has the honour to inform him that Germany has taken the following measures regarding the implementation of Security Council resolution 1054 (1996) of 26 April 1996:

- (a) Germany has reduced the diplomatic personnel of the Sudanese Embassy in Bonn by one diplomat (from seven to six);
- (b) Germany has limited the freedom of movement of members of the Sudanese Embassy in Bonn to a radius of 50 kilometres around Bonn. The Foreign Office will have to be notified, in advance, of any trips outside this radius;
- (c) Germany has implemented a particularly restrictive policy for issuing visas to members of the Sudanese Government and other officials.
