Statement by the European Union on the bomb attack
in Saudi Arabia, issued on 26 June 1996

The European Union has learned with horror and indignation the news of the terrorist attack on the American headquarters in Dahran, in which so many people lost their lives or were wounded, criminally carried out when Secretary of State Warren Christopher is engaged in a new, delicate peace mission in the region.

This attack is the last wave of a tragic chain of hostile criminal acts perpetrated against those who serve in favour of peace in the Middle East.

In expressing its condolences to the relatives of the victims, the European Union wishes to reaffirm, as solemnly reiterated at the recent meeting of the European Council in Florence, its absolute condemnation of the scourge of terrorism and political violence and its continuing support for stabilization and peace-building in the Middle East.
