NOTE VERBALE DATED 25 JUNE 1996 FROM THE PERMANENT
MISSION OF DENMARK TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Denmark to the United Nations has the honour to refer to the Secretary-General's note of 15 May 1996 concerning the implementation of Security Council resolution 1054 (1996) of 26 April 1996 and wishes to submit the following information:

Denmark has no diplomatic or consular representation in the Sudan, or vice versa. The Sudanese Ambassador residing in Stockholm is accredited also to Denmark. Consequently, there has been no need for any action to be taken by the Government of Denmark for the implementation of paragraph 3 (a) of the resolution.

Concerning paragraph 3 (b) of the resolution, the Government of Denmark has adopted the necessary visa regulations in order to prevent the entry into or transit through the territory of Denmark of members of the Government of the Sudan, officials of that Government and members of the Sudanese armed forces.
