LETTER DATED 27 JUNE 1996 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF BELGIUM
TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you of the measures taken pursuant to paragraph 3 of resolution 1054 (1996) of 26 April 1996, imposing diplomatic sanctions on the Sudan.

In accordance with a decision by the Belgian authorities, the diplomatic staff of the Sudanese Embassy in Brussels has been reduced from five to four.

The Sudanese diplomats remaining in Brussels will be required to have prior authorization from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs for any travel outside the Greater Brussels area. The Belgian Government will not participate in and will not be represented at any meetings held by international or regional organizations in the Sudan. It has also decided that it will no longer authorize members of the Sudanese Government, officials of that Government or members of the Sudanese armed forces to enter Belgium.
