List of candidates submitted by Governments

Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. Article 4 of the Statute of the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea requires that its Members be elected at a Meeting of States Parties from a list of persons nominated by the States Parties to the Convention.
- 2. In accordance with the provisions of article 4 and other relevant provisions of the Statute and of the Convention and the decision of the Meeting of States Parties (SPLOS/3, para. 10), the Secretary-General, in a note verbale dated 27 March 1995, invited Governments to submit the names of the candidates they might wish to nominate for election to the Tribunal, bearing in mind the decisions taken by the Meeting of States Parties on the matter. The Secretary-General addressed a further note dated 18 April 1996 to the States Parties and observer States, reminding them of the closing date, 17 June 1996, for the receipt of nominations.
- 3. Article 4, paragraph 2, of the Statute provides that the Secretary-General shall prepare a list in alphabetical order of all the persons thus nominated, with an indication of the States Parties which have nominated them. The nominations submitted by States Parties to the Secretary-General in reply to his request are, pursuant to article 4 of the Statute, set out in the annex to the present note.
- 4. The curricula vitae of the candidates will be circulated in document SPLOS/11.
