Addendum

- 1. In paragraph 11 of my report to the Security Council dated 27 June 1996 (S/1996/502), I indicated my intention to issue an addendum to the report with details of the financial implications of the proposed three-month extension of the United Nations Mission of Observers in Prevlaka (UNMOP) until 15 October 1996.
- 2. The cost of maintaining UNMOP for a 12-month period beginning on 1 July 1996 was estimated at \$2 million in my report of 29 March 1996 on the financing of the United Nations Mission in Bosnia and Herzegovina (UNMIBH) (A/50/906). Although an independent mission, for administrative and budgetary purposes, UNMOP is treated as part of UNMIBH. Therefore, should the Council decide to extend the mandate of UNMOP, in its present composition, for a further three-month period as I have recommended, the cost for the extension period would be \$500,000.
