TELEGRAM DATED 6 FEBRUARY 1979 FROM THE DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER IN CHARGE OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF DEMOCRATIC KAMPUCHEA ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Since the beginning of February 1979, Viet Nam has sent to Kampuchea, besides the 14 divisions which it is already maintaining there, three additional divisions for the eastern, south-western and Phnom Penh fronts for the purpose of intensifying its invasion and its barbaric crimes against Democratic Kampuchea and the people of Kampuchea. The people of Kampuchea have acted unanimously in taking up arms to drive the Vietnamese invaders from Kampuchea and have defeated the Vietnamese policy of Khmerizing the war of aggression against Kampuchea by making Khmers fight Khmers. As a result of this defeat, Viet Nam has decided to intensify its aggression and its invasion of Kampuchea in an even more fascistic and cruel manner in disregard of the condemnation expressed by all countries devoted to peace, justice and independence, which are demanding that Viet Nam halt its invasion and immediately withdraw all its invasion forces from Kampuchea. The Government of Democratic Kampuchea appeals to the United Nations and to all countries devoted to peace, justice and independence to intensify their efforts aimed at:

- (1) Denouncing and condemning Viet Nam's invasion and crimes directed against Democratic Kampuchea and the people of Kampuchea;
- (2) Compelling Viet Nam to halt its invasion and immediately withdraw all its armed forces from Kampuchea, to halt its barbaric crimes gainst the people of Kampuchea and to respect the independence, sovereignty and territorial integrity of Kampuchea;
- (3) Halting all aid and assistance, even of a humanitarian nature, to Viet Nam, which is not hesitating to traffic in refugees and to make use of such aid and assistance in order to intensify its invasion and its crimes against Kampuchea;
- (4) Providing comprehensive aid and support to the just struggle of the people of Kampuchea and of the Government of Democratic Kampuchea.

I should be grateful if you would have this telegram circulated as a Security Council document.
