NOTE VERBALE DATED 10 JULY 1996 FROM THE PERMANENT
REPRESENTATIVE OF AUSTRALIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Australia to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour, in conformity with paragraph 3 of Security Council resolution 1054 (1996) of 26 April 1996, to inform him of the measures taken by Australia to implement the provisions of that paragraph.

The Government of Australia has amended its Migration Regulations and instructed all diplomatic missions and consulates of Australia abroad to restrict visas for entry into and transit through Australia to any person who is a member or an official of the Government of the Sudan or a member of the armed forces of the Sudan, until further notice. In respect of subparagraph 3 (a) of the above-mentioned resolution, the Sudan has no diplomatic mission in Australia and Australia has no embassy in the Sudan.
