NOTE VERBALE DATED 1 JULY 1996 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF POLAND TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of the Republic of Poland to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour, with reference to his note dated 15 May 1996, to inform him of the following:

Since Poland has no diplomatic representation in the Sudan and the Sudan has no diplomatic representation in Poland, no action has been deemed necessary by the Polish Government for the implementation of paragraph 3 (a) of resolution 1054 (1996).

As to paragraph 3 (b) of the resolution, Poland will restrict issuing entry or transit visas for members of the Government of the Sudan, officials of that Government and members of the Sudanese armed forces. Furthermore, to date, no person who can be qualified as belonging to these categories has entered or transited through the territory of the Republic of Poland.
