NOTE VERBALE DATED 10 JULY 1996 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION
OF LITHUANIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE
SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Lithuania presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to his note of 15 May 1996 on the implementation of Security Council resolution 1054 (1996) of 26 April 1996.

Since Lithuania and the Sudan have no diplomatic missions or consular posts in their respective territories, the provisions of paragraph 3 (a) of resolution 1054 (1996) are not applicable.

Pursuant to paragraph 3 (b) of resolution 1054 (1996), the Government of the Republic of Lithuania has taken all necessary measures to restrict the entry into and transit through the territory of Lithuania by members of the Government of Sudan, officials of the Government and members of the Sudanese armed forces.
