- 1. The Secretary-General has received two additional nominations for election to the Board of Trustees of the International Research and Training Institute for the Advancement of Women.
- 2. The following candidate was nominated by the Government of Iraq:

Muna Younis Bahri Salih (Iraq). Currently Professor, College of Education, Ibn Rushd, Baghdad University. Received B.A. from College of Women, Baghdad University and M.A. and Ph.D. from Ohio State University, United States of America. Has participated in international conferences, including the World Conference to Review and Appraise the Achievements of the United Nations Decade for Women: Equality, Development and Peace (Nairobi, 15-26 July 1985). Has authored various publications on women's issues, education and environmental education.

3. The following candidate was nominated by the Government of Mauritius:

Indira Savitree Thacoor-Sidaya (Mauritius). Minister of Women, Family Welfare and Child Development since December 1995. Member of the Politburo Responsible for Protocol and Coordinator for Women's Affairs, and Member of Mauritius National Assembly for the constituency of Port Louis/Montagne Longue. Collaborated with UNICEF to conceive and launch an identification and intervention programme for developmentally delayed children. Educator

and lecturer since 1976. Undergraduate studies at Delhi University, India, and postgraduate studies at Cape Town and Reunion Island. Participated in seminars and training courses.
