NOTE VERBALE DATED 20 JUNE 1996 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CANADA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Canada to the United Nations has the honour to refer to the diplomatic note of the Secretary-General of 15 May 1996, requesting information on the implementation of paragraph 3 of Security Council resolution 1054 (1996) of 26 April 1996 and the imposition of diplomatic and travel measures affecting the Government of the Sudan.

The Government of Canada informed the Government of the Sudan on 19 June 1996 that:

- (a) The Government of the Sudan's representation in Canada will be frozen at the present low level of two diplomats;
- (b) The movements in Canada of Sudanese Embassy personnel, without prior authority, will be limited to the National Capital region;
- (c) The entry or transit of members, officials or military personnel of the Government of the Sudan into or through Canada will be denied or restricted;
- (d) Representatives of Canadian Government departments or agencies will be enjoined not to organize or attend international conferences or meetings in the Sudan, with the exception of accredited diplomatic personnel.

The above measures will remain in effect until further notice.
