NOTE VERBALE DATED 16 JULY 1996 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF NEW ZEALAND TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of New Zealand presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to inform him of measures taken by the New Zealand Government in conformity with paragraph 3 of resolution 1054 (1996) of 26 April 1996.

The Sudan does not have diplomatic or consular representation in New Zealand, nor does New Zealand have diplomatic or consular representation in the Sudan. As a result, the first measure encompassed by resolution 1054 (1996) has no application for New Zealand.

As for the second measure encompassed by the resolution, restrictions on travel to or through New Zealand by members or officials of the Government of the Sudan, or of the Sudanese armed forces, have been implemented in New Zealand through existing immigration legislation.
