REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL PURSUANT TO SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 1054 (1996)

Addendum

1. Since the issuance of my report to the Council of 10 July 1996 (S/1996/541) and the addendum of 17 July 1996 (S/1996/541/Add.1), a further five replies have been received, bringing to 53 the total of replies received as at 23 July 1996. All the replies have been published as documents of the Security Council (see annex).

INFORMATION RECEIVED IN RESPECT OF PARAGRAPH 3 OF RESOLUTION 1054 (1996)

2. The five replies received from Member States provided information regarding paragraph 3 of resolution 1054 (1996). One State reported that it did not have diplomatic or consular relations with the Sudan but had, none the less, taken the necessary steps to comply strictly with the provisions of the resolution. Two States reported that they had taken appropriate measures in compliance with paragraph 3 (b) and further indicated that, as they did not have diplomatic representation in the Sudan nor did the Sudan have diplomatic representation in their country, no action was required by them under paragraph 3 (a) of the resolution. The remaining two States reported that they had taken action in compliance with paragraph 3 (a) and (b) of the resolution.
