NOTE VERBALE DATED 18 JULY 1996 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF JORDAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to Security Council resolution 1054 (1996) of 26 April 1996, has the honour to inform him that the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan is placing restrictions on the granting to Sudanese citizens of visas for entry into Jordanian territory and that the number of staff at the Sudanese Embassy in Amman is being reduced to three in addition to the Ambassador, a small number that is only just sufficient to cover the work of the Embassy.
