The Permanent Observer Mission of Switzerland to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General and, following the adoption by the Security Council of resolution 1054 (1996), has the honour to inform him as follows:

Since the Sudan has no diplomatic representation in Switzerland, the Swiss Government did not deem it necessary to take any particular measures in implementation of paragraph 3 (a) of the resolution. With regard to paragraph 3 (b) of the resolution, the Mission requests the Secretariat to refer to its note of 20 May 1996. The Swiss Government has furthermore decided that applications for visas for members of the Permanent Mission of the Republic of the Sudan to the United Nations Office at Geneva and specialized agencies in Switzerland shall be considered favourably only in so far as the applicant is, indeed, replacing another member of the Mission.
