Mr. President.

I have the honour to bring to Mr. President's notice that:

In furtherance to the 8 January 1979 message of Mr. Heng Samrin, President of the People's Revolutionary Council of the People's Republic of Kampuchea sent to Mr. Donald O. Mills, Ambassador of Jamaica, the then President of the United Nations Security Council, I would like to reaffirm that: the People's Revolutionary Council of the People's Republic of Kampuchea is the only authentic legal representative of the people of Kampuchea. The Pol Pot-Ieng Sary clique was overthrown by the people of Kampuchea, they no longer represent anybody, has no right to speak at any forum anything whatsoever on behalf of Kampuchea. All meetings of the Security Council to discuss questions related to Kampuchea must have the representative of the People's Republic of Kampuchea appointed by the People's Revolutionary Council of Kampuchea to take part and strictly respect the independence, sovereignty of Kampuchea in conformity with the United Nations Charter and international law; all meetings of the Security Council on questions related to Kampuchea in which there is no participation of representatives of the People's Revolutionary Council of Kampuchea are null and void.

Please accept, Mr. President, the assurances of my highest consideration.
