NOTE VERBALE DATED 8 AUGUST 1996 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF ROMANIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Romania to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General and has the honour to inform him of the measures taken by the Government of Romania in compliance with paragraph 3 of Security Council resolution 1054 (1996) of 26 April 1996.

The Government of Romania has asked the Government of the Sudan to reduce the number of its diplomats at the Sudanese Embassy in Bucharest by one. Sudanese diplomats remaining in Bucharest have been required to notify the Romanian Foreign Ministry of all intended journeys outside the Bucharest area.

The Government of Romania, pursuant to paragraph 3 (b) of resolution 1054 (1996), has instructed all diplomatic missions and consulates of Romania abroad to restrict the entry or transit visas for members of the Government of the Sudan, officials of that Government and members of the Sudanese armed forces.
