LETTER DATED 8 AUGUST 1996 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE
SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to transmit to you herewith a letter dated 7 August 1996 addressed to you by Mr. Mohammed Said Al-Sahaf, Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Iraq, enclosing a number of tables listing the Turkish violations committed between 7 August 1991 and 18 July 1996.

I should be grateful if you would have the present letter and its annex circulated as a document of the Security Council.

Annex

Letter dated 7 August 1996 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs
of Iraq addressed to the Secretary-General

I should like to inform you that, in violation of Iraq's sovereignty and territorial integrity, incursions into the country's territory and airspace by Turkish armed forces are still continuing on the pretext of pursuing elements that pose a threat to Turkey's national security. The anomalous situation prevailing in northern Iraq, which has been created by the large-scale military presence of the United States of America and its allies in Turkish territory, is thus being exploited, and the two neighbouring countries are being prevented from resolving the issues that have disturbed good-neighbourly relations between them.

Since 1991, after each assault by Turkish forces on Iraq's sovereignty and territorial integrity, the Government of Iraq has alerted the Government of Turkey to the dangerous consequences of violations that pose a threat not only to the sovereignty of Iraq but also to peace and stability in the region and in the world as a whole.

As I have told you in my earlier letters, the Turkish Government bears full international responsibility for the acts of aggression being carried out by its armed forces inside Iraqi territory and for all of their consequences.

The Government of Iraq reserves its right under international law to seek compensation for the damage caused by these Turkish violations of its territory and its airspace. Through you, it renews its call to the Government of Turkey to reconsider its policy with respect to the situation in northern Iraq, to bring an end to a dangerous situation that poses a threat to security and stability and to promote cooperation between the two countries on the basis of good-neighbourliness and mutual respect.

As I reiterate my country's appeal to its Turkish neighbour, through you, to respect Iraq's sovereignty and territorial integrity, I express the hope that the United Nations will meet the responsibilities entrusted to it under its Charter and that it will bring a halt to the intimidation and aggression to which my country is constantly being subjected.

I take this opportunity to transmit to you a list in tabular form of the letters of protest sent by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Iraq to the Turkish Embassy in Baghdad between 7 August 1991 and 18 July 1996.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
