Letter dated 22 August 1996 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Eritrea addressed to the Special Envoy of the President of France

The unilateral decision we have undertaken to evacuate from Lesser Hanish in order to ensure that the arbitration process is not hampered and to avoid getting immersed in unnecessary wrangling remains in place.

However, there are indications that establish an unbridled Yemeni intention to occupy Lesser Hanish when we evacuate it. If this transpires, it will precipitate a very dangerous situation. Rather than complaining and regretting the fact after it occurs, it is imperative that guarantees be made <u>a priori</u> to avert such a dangerous eventuality. In this spirit, we wish to request, in advance, your views and stance on the vital matter of guarantees.
