LETTER DATED 20 AUGUST 1996 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I.  
OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO

According to information received from officials of the Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran:

1. On 7 April 1996, a United States frigate named YENDOR60GFFSIWADM at the position of N2852 and E5022 violated the territorial waters of the Islamic Republic of Iran and fled the region after receiving warning.
2. On 18 April 1996, at 1400 hours, a United States warship at the position of N2905 and E5015 created a nuisance for Iranian helicopter AB-212.

The Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran protests these illegal measures by the United States Government and calls for an end to such actions.
