LETTER DATED 26 AUGUST 1996 FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION 918 (1994) CONCERNING RWANDA ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to resolution 1011 (1995), adopted by the Security Council on 16 August 1995, regarding the situation in Rwanda. By paragraph 11 of that resolution, the Committee is required to report to the Council on notifications received from States on the export of arms and related material to Rwanda, as well as notifications of imports of arms and related material made by the Government of Rwanda.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that the Committee established pursuant to resolution 918 (1994) concerning Rwanda has received the following notification:

On 21 August 1996, from the Government of Singapore for the export of spare parts for vehicles from the Tata Engineering Services (Pte) Ltd. (a Singapore company) to Rwanda through the entry point of Rusumo, Rwanda, via the port of Dar es Salaam, United Republic of Tanzania. The total value of the shipment is f.o.b. US\$ 155,355.12.
