The Ministry of Foreign Affairs presents its compliments to the Secretary-General and has the honour to forward the response regarding the implementation of Security Council resolution 1054 (1996) of 26 April 1996.

The Republic of Macedonia established diplomatic relations with the Sudan prior to the adoption of Security Council resolution 1054 (1996). Yet, the Republic of Macedonia and the Sudan have no diplomatic missions or consular posts in their respective territories.

The Government of the Republic of Macedonia, pursuant to paragraph 3 (b) of resolution 1054 (1996), has instructed the relevant authorities and institutions within the country to take appropriate measures to restrict entry into and transit through the territory of Macedonia by members of the Government of the Sudan, officials of the Government and members of Sudanese armed forces.
