LETTER DATED 30 AUGUST 1996 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to resolution 1011 (1995), adopted by the Security Council on 16 August 1995, regarding the situation in Rwanda. In paragraph 12 of that resolution I was requested to report to the Council within 6 months of the date of adoption of the resolution, and again within 12 months, regarding, in particular, the export of arms and related matériel to the Government of Rwanda, on the basis of reports submitted by the Committee established pursuant to resolution 918 (1994) concerning Rwanda. The reports are contained in documents S/1996/202 and S/1996/663/Rev.1.

I wish to inform you that since the issuance of my second report (S/1996/663/Rev.1), the Committee established pursuant to resolution 918 (1994) concerning Rwanda has received the following notification with regard to the export to the Government of Rwanda of arms and related matériel which has been published as a document of the Security Council:

On 21 August 1996, from the Government of Singapore for the export of spare parts for vehicles from the Tata Engineering Services (Pte) Ltd. (a Singapore company) to Rwanda through the entry point of Rusumo, Rwanda, via the port of Dar es Salaam, United Republic of Tanzania (S/1996/697). The total value of the shipment is f.o.b. US\$ 155,335.12.
