Corrigendum

On page 1 of the annex, the sixth paragraph should read

In analysing the enemy's aims in committing aggression against Front-Line States, the Summit noted with indignation that the unprovoked and premeditated war of aggression launched by the régime of Idi Amin against the United Republic of Tanzania serves the objective of the enemy by undermining the struggle against the minority racist régimes, for Idi Amin's aggression can only be designed to force Tanzania to divert her resources from the liberation struggle to the defence of her sovereignty and territorial integrity.
