Statement issued on 4 September 1996 by the Ministry of
Foreign Affairs of Kazakhstan

With respect to the latest developments in Iraq, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Kazakhstan is concerned that there exists a real threat of an escalation in military action, which would lead to increased tension around the Persian Gulf, with adverse consequences for peace and security in the region. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs is of the opinion that a solution to the conflict may be achieved through scrupulous adherence to the relevant resolutions of the United Nations Security Council.
