LETTER DATED 11 JUNE 1981 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF TUNISIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT
OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to transmit to you the text, reproduced below, of the message addressed on 8 June 1981 by H.E. Habib Bourguiba, President of the Republic of Tunisia, to H.E. Saddam Hussein, President of the Republic of Iraq, following Israel's act of aggression against Iraq.

"We have learned with deep indignation of the despicable aggression and act of international terrorism perpetrated by Israel against our brother Iraqi people. In this situation, in which it is the duty of the international community to condemn this flagrant aggression, we wish to assure you of the absolute solidarity of the Tunisian people and to reaffirm to you our determination to continue the struggle until such criminal actions against the Arab nation and its achievements cease."

Kindly have this message distributed as a document of the Security Council.
