LETTER DATED 15 JUNE 1981 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE  
OF GRENADA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT  
OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to present my compliments to you and to inform you, in your capacity as President of the Security Council of the United Nations, that the Government of Grenada has sent the following message from Prime Minister Maurice Bishop to President Saddam Hussein of Iraq.

"On behalf of the People's Revolutionary Government of Grenada, the people of Grenada, and on my own behalf, I extend to your Excellency firmest solidarity in face of Zionist Israel's latest act of aggression against your homeland and noble people.

We strongly deplore and condemn Israel's bombing raid on your two nuclear reactors. We view this development with the utmost seriousness and recognize it as a flagrant violation of international law and, in particular, the hallowed principles of territorial integrity, national sovereignty and peaceful co-existence.

Since we are unswervingly committed to these sacred principles we stand firmly with you, the Government and people of the Republic of Iraq, and once again express our support as you face up to zionism and its provocations."

I have the honour to request that this letter be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
