LETTER DATED 17 JUNE 1981 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I.
OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF SURINAME TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to transmit to you the statement of the Government of the Republic of Suriname issued in connexion with the Israeli aggression against the Iraqi nuclear installation near Baghdad:

"The Government of the Republic of Suriname has learnt with great perturbation of the air attack by Israel on the Iraqi nuclear research centre at Tuwaitha, near Baghdad, on June 7, 1981.

It is of the opinion that this act is a flagrant violation of the national sovereignty, territorial integrity and security of Iraq and, therefore, strongly condemns this act of aggression, which constitutes a grave menace to international peace and security.

It would be highly appreciated if this letter could be circulated as a document of the Security Council."
