The Council of Ministers of OAU, meeting at its 37th Ordinary Session in Nairobi, Kenya, on 15 June 1981, expresses its profound indignation at the barbarous aggression recently committed by the Zionist régime of Israel against the Iraqi installation at Tamuz, in flagrant violation of the sovereignty and territorial integrity of Iraq. This act of aggression is further proof of the arrogance of Israel, which is continuing to defy the international community, violating international law and jeopardizing the search for a peaceful solution in the Middle East.
