## Allocation of items to the Second Committee

1. Report of the Economic and Social Council [chaps. I, III, IV, V (sects. B to E and H) and VII] (item 12).

[The General Assembly decided that the chapters of the report listed below would be referred also to plenary meetings and to the Third and Fifth Committees, as follows:

- (a) Chapters I and VII ............... Plenary meetings and Third and Fifth Committees
- (b) Chapters III and IV ...... Plenary meetings and Third Committee
- (c) Chapter V (sect. E) ...... Third and Fifth Committees]
- 2. Macroeconomic policy questions (item 94):
  - (a) External debt crisis and development;
  - (b) Financing of development, including net transfer of resources between developing and developed countries;
  - (c) Trade and development;
  - (d) Commodities.

[The General Assembly also decided that the report of the Secretary-General on the progress at mid-decade on the implementation of General Assembly resolution 45/217 on the World Summit for Children (A/51/256), which is relevant to item 98 and to item 106 (Promotion and protection of the rights of children) should be introduced in

plenary and referred also to the Third Committee for consideration under item 106.]
