SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

## Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3679th meeting, held on 11 July 1996, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Angola Verification Mission (UNAVEM III) (S/1996/503).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Algeria, Angola, Brazil, Cape Verde, Malawi, Mozambique, Portugal, South Africa, Tunisia, the United Republic of Tanzania and Zimbabwe, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1996/536) that had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1996/536, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1064 (1996) (for the text, see S/RES/1064 (1996); to be issued in <u>Official Records of the Security Council</u>, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1996).

The situation in Georgia (see S/23370/Add.40, S/25070/Add.4, S/25070/Add.26, S/25070/Add.27, S/25070/Add.31, S/25070/Add.34, S/25070/Add.37, S/25070/Add.42, S/25070/Add.44, S/25070/Add.45, S/25070/Add.51, S/1994/20/Add.4, S/1994/20/Add.8, S/1994/20/Add.9, S/1994/20/Add.11, S/1994/20/Add.13, S/1994/20/Add.25, S/1994/20/Add.28, S/1994/20/Add.47, S/1995/40/Add.1, S/1995/40/Add.10, S/1995/40/Add.18, S/1995/40/Add.32, S/1996/15/Add.1 and S/1996/15/Add.16)

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Georgia and Ireland, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1996/544) that had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1996/544, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1065 (1996) (for the text, see S/RES/1065 (1996); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1996).
