INFORMATION FURNISHED IN CONFORMITY WITH THE CONVENTION ON REGISTRATION OF OBJECTS LAUNCHED INTO OUTER SPACE

Note verbale dated 12 July 1996 from the Permanent Mission of the Czech Republic to the United Nations (Vienna) addressed to the Secretary-General

The Permanent Mission of the Czech Republic to the United Nations (Vienna) presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to inform him that, in accordance with article II of the Convention on Registration of Objects Launched into Outer Space,* the Czech Republic has established the Czech National Register of Objects Launched into Outer Space by the Czech Republic within its National Space Programme and with international cooperation. The Register will be maintained by the Institute of Atmospheric Physics of the Czech Academy of Sciences.

The Czechoslovak National Register of Objects, established on 13 January 1979 (ST/SG/SER.E/INF.5), has not been in use since 1 January 1993. Documents concerning satellites MAGION 1, MAGION 2 and MAGION 3 are still kept at the Institute of Atmospheric Physics of the Czech Academy of Sciences.
