MISSION OF SINGAPORE TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Singapore to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to his note dated 23 August 1996, has the honour to inform him that the Government of Singapore complies fully with the provisions of paragraph 3 of Security Council resolution 1054 (1996) of 26 April 1996 regarding diplomatic sanctions against the Government of the Sudan.

Singapore and the Sudan have no diplomatic or consular representatives in their respective territories. Appropriate measures have been taken with regard to the entry into or transit through Singapore territory by Sudanese nationals included in the provisions set forth in paragraph 3 of Security Council resolution 1054 (1996).
