LETTER DATED 16 MARCH 1979 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF ANGOLA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Upon the instructions of my Government, I have the honour to request that an urgent meeting of the Security Council be convened in connexion with the question of the South African aggression against the People's Republic of Angola, especially in the light of the recent and continuing acts of aggression and violations of the sovereignty and territorial integrity of my country, by the racist South African régime.

The intensity and timing of these racist attacks pose a definite threat to peace negotiations in southern Africa and hence affect international peace and security.
