APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS AND
OTHER APPOINTMENTS: APPOINTMENT OF A MEMBER OF THE
BOARD OF AUDITORS

Note by the Secretary-General

1. As indicated in document A/51/103 of 7 March 1996, it will be necessary for the General Assembly, during its current session, to appoint the Auditor-General (or officer holding the equivalent title) of a Member State to fill the vacancy that will arise in the membership of the United Nations Board of Auditors, effective 30 June 1997.
2. The Government of Ghana has nominated the Auditor-General of Ghana for reappointment to the United Nations Board of Auditors for a term of office beginning on 1 July 1997 and ending on 30 June 2000.
