## Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. Further to his communications of 1 July 1981 (see A/35/805) and 31 July 1981 (see A/35/805/Add.1), the President of the General Assembly, on 11 September 1981, informed the Secretary-General, on the basis of information transmitted to him by the Chairman of the Group of Asian States, that he had appointed Malaysia, the Philippines, Thailand and the United Arab Emirates as members of the Preparatory Committee for the United Nations Conference for the Promotion of International Co-operation in the Peaceful Uses of Nuclear Energy.
