- 1. - 2. Upon the conclusion of the resumed second regular session of 1981, the repertorial summary sections of the fascicles will be consolidated into a single bound volume, which will also contain the usual annexes. The resolutions and decisions of each session will be published in separate books as parts of Supplement No. 1 to the Official Records of the Council.
