ALGERIA

[Original: French]

1. Algeria fully supported resolution 50/10 and voted in favour of it. It therefore endorses the provisions of paragraphs 2 and 3 of the resolution.
2. Accordingly, the Government of Algeria has neither promulgated nor applied any laws whose extraterritorial effects would undermine the sovereignty of other States.

JAMAICA

[Original: English]

[25 October 1996]

1. The Government of Jamaica has not introduced any laws or measures which restrict the freedom of trade and navigation with Cuba.
2. Further, the Government of Jamaica reiterates its opposition to the extraterritorial application of national legislation which seeks to impose artificial barriers to trade and are contrary to international law and to the principle of the sovereign equality of States.
