QUESTION OF THE COMPOSITION OF THE RELEVANT ORGANS

Report of the Special Political and Decolonization
Committee (Fourth Committee)

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 20 September 1996, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fifty-first session the item entitled "Question of the composition of the relevant organs of the United Nations" and to allocate it to the Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee).
2. The Fourth Committee considered the item at its 6th meeting, on 16 October 1996 (see A/C.4/51/SR.6).
3. At its 6th meeting, the Fourth Committee, on the proposal of the representative of the Netherlands, supported by the representative of Romania, recommended that the General Assembly delete from its agenda the item entitled "Question of the composition of the relevant organs of the United Nations" (see para. 4).
