NOTE BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

1. By a letter dated 23 March 1979 (S/13191) the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established in pursuance of resolution 253 (1968) concerning the question of Southern Rhodesia transmitted the Committee's interim report in implementation of paragraph 8 of Security Council resolution 445 (1979). The interim report contained, among other things, a request for extension of the date for submission of the report called for in the above-mentioned paragraph to 12 April 1979.
2. Following informal consultations on the matter, it has been found that no member of the Security Council has any objection to the Committee's request, and the Chairman of the Committee has been so informed.
3. Accordingly, the date of the Security Council's meeting to consider the Committee's report, as called for in paragraph 9 of the Council's resolution 445 (1979), will be fixed at a later stage.
