Appointment of members of the United Nations
Administrative Tribunal

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Igor V. GOUMENNY (Ukraine)

1. At its 24th meeting, on 8 November 1996, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/51/105) concerning the vacancies in the membership of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal that will occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of two of its members on 31 December 1996.

2. The Fifth Committee also had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/51/16) containing the names of two persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment to the Administrative Tribunal for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 1997.

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint Mr. Julio Barboza (Argentina) and Mr. Mayer Gabay (Israel) as members of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 1997.
