REQUEST FOR THE INCLUSION OF A SUPPLEMENTARY ITEM IN THE AGENDA OF THE THIRTY-SIXTH SESSION

SOLEMN OBSERVANCE OF THE TWENTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FIRST CONFERENCE OF HEADS OF STATE OR GOVERNMENT OF NON-ALIGNED COUNTRIES

Letter dated 14 August 1981 from the Permanent Representative of Cuba to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

ANNEX

Explanatory memorandum

- 1. The year 1981 marks the twentieth anniversary of the First Conference of Heads of State or Government of Non-Aligned Countries, held at Belgrade from 1 to 6 September 1961.
- 2. From a founding membership of 25 countries, the Movement of Non-Aligned Countries has now a membership embracing all regions of the world and representing virtually two thirds of the United Nations, attesting to the increasing validity of its principles.
- 3. The policy of non-alignment and the Movement of Non-Aligned Countries have in the last 20 years played a positive and potent role in the development of international relations on the basis of peaceful co-operation among nations, in the promotion and strengthening of international peace and security, disarmament, decolonization and the establishment of a new international economic order. In this context, during these 20 years, the Movement of Non-Aligned Countries has significantly contributed to the strengthening of the role of the United Nations Organization and its various organs and agencies.
- 4. It is therefore appropriate that during the thirty-sixth session of the General Assembly, the twentieth anniversary of the First Conference of Heads of State or Government of Non-Aligned Countries, held at Belgrade in 1961, be observed.
