Appointment of a member of the Board of Auditors

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Igor V. GOUMENNY (Ukraine)

1. At its 24th meeting, on 8 November 1996, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/51/103) concerning the vacancy in the membership of the United Nations Board of Auditors that will occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of one of its members on 30 June 1997.
2. The Auditor-General of Ghana was nominated by his Government for reappointment as a member of the Board of Auditors for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 July 1997.
3. The Fifth Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend the Auditor-General of Ghana for appointment as a member of the Board of Auditors for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 July 1997.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

4. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly appoint the Auditor-General of Ghana as a member of the United Nations Board of Auditors for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 July 1997.
