Appointment of members of the International Civil Service
Commission

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Igor V. GOUMENNY (Ukraine)

1. At its 24th meeting, on 8 November 1996, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/51/106) concerning the vacancies in the membership of the International Civil Service Commission that will occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of five of its members on 31 December 1996.

2. The Fifth Committee also had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/51/17) containing the names of persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment as members of the International Civil Service Commission, which included two persons for the two vacancies to be filled by candidates from the African States, one person for the vacancy to be filled by a candidate from the Eastern European States and two persons for the two vacancies to be filled by candidates from the Asian States.

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend the appointment of Mr. Ernest Rusita (Uganda), Mr. El Hassane Zahid (Morocco), Mr. Alexander V. Chepourin (Russian Federation), Ms. Corazon Alma de Leon (Philippines) and Mr. Humayun Kabir (Bangladesh) to the International Civil Service Commission for a four-year term of office beginning 1 January 1997.

4. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly appoint the following persons as members of the International Civil Service Commission for a four-year term of office beginning 1 January 1997:

Mr. El Hassane Zahid.
