LETTER DATED 11 JANUARY 1977 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES, A.I., OF
THE PERMANENT MISSION OF MOROCCO TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED
TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to the letter addressed to you on 22 December 1976 by the Permanent Representative of Botswana to the United Nations (S/12262) in which he requests you to convene an urgent meeting of the Security Council to consider the situation resulting from the acts of aggression committed against Botswana by the illegal régime of Southern Rhodesia.

The African Group has instructed me to inform you that it fully supports this request and that it expects the Security Council to take the necessary measures.

I would be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a Security Council document.
