Letter dated 22 March 1977 from the Chargé d'affaires a.i.
of the Permanent Mission of Ghana to the United Nations
addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour, on instructions, to communicate the text of a resolution adopted at the 117th Executive Committee session of the World Federation of the United Nations Associations (WFUNA) held in Accra, Ghana, from 19 to 21 March 1977, as follows:

"The Executive Committee of the World Federation of the United Nations Associations at its 117th session, held in Accra from 19 to 21 March 1977, was gravely concerned by persistent reliable reports that, with the help of outside interests, South Africa has been making rapid progress towards becoming an armed nuclear power.

"The Executive Committee reaffirms the Federation's many resolutions condemning apartheid and calling attention to the dangers to peace resulting from the persistence of the Government of South Africa in its racist policies.

"The Executive Committee further reaffirms the Federation's resolutions calling attention to the dangers of nuclear proliferation and recognizes that a particularly grave danger to the peace of the world will result from the possession of nuclear weapons by the Government of South Africa.

"In view of the foregoing considerations, the Executive Committee requests that the Security Council of the United Nations should give urgent

consideration to the taking of immediate steps to ensure that no State, multinational or other body or person be allowed to provide South Africa or Rhodesia with any equipment, technology or production of nuclear weapons of any kind.

"The Executive Committee directs its acting President, its Chairman and Secretary-General to convey the text of this resolution to the President of the Security Council by cable.

"The Executive Committee also respectfully asks the Government of Ghana to take steps to present this resolution on behalf of the Executive Committee of WFUMA to the current meetings of the Security Council and also to the next session of the General Assembly and circulated as a United Nations document."

May I kindly request that the foregoing resolution be circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under items 26, 42 and 89 of the preliminary list, and of the Security Council.
