LETTER DATED 23 DECEMBER 1978 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF EGYPT TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Yesterday, Egypt tagether with the International Community deplored Israel's aggression against Lebanon. Notwithstanding such wide condemnation Israel, today, has once again reverbated to committing a new act of aggression against Lebanon by shelling Lebanese territory by means of long-range artillery.

This new set of aggression confirms Israel's consistent policy of violating the basic norms and principles of International Law as well as the endangering of international peace and security. Further, such irresponsible action has gravely imperiled the lives of Lebanese civilians and those of the United Nations Interim Forces.

Such action, no doubt, is a flagrant defiance of the efforts undertaken by the United States, in co-operation with Egypt, towards the elimination of the obstacles placed by Israel to hinder the process of establishing a just and lasting peace in the Middle East.
